

# FirstEnergy's Pennsylvania utilities Energy Efficient New Homes Program

**Financial incentives are available for builders of new homes serviced by Met-Ed, Penelec, Penn Power or West Penn Power.**





The program offers two incentive tiers for builders of homes that exceed the minimum energy code.

With incentives measured by total kWh saved annually, the more builders save the more they earn. Builders of qualifying homes can earn a maximum incentive of \$4,500. For multifamily projects, builders can earn *thousands* of dollars per building with rebates issued on a per-unit basis.

Program participants are eligible to receive free technical trainings, marketing materials and recognition on the program website's *Builder Showcase*.

All homes must be inspected and verified by a certified HERS Rater to qualify for program incentives. ENERGY STAR-certified homes must also complete all V3.1 checklists.
